



# INTRODUCTION

Global Ehsan Relief is a humanitarian aid relief agency, a registered NGO in Singapore, Malaysia, Indonesia, Cambodia and Sri Lanka.

We are dedicated to providing humanitarian services in crisis and non-crisis situations to most needy orphans, widows and destitute, irrespective of race, religion, culture, creed and geographical boundary.

As a leading and well-established humanitarian charity based in Singapore, Global Ehsan Relief work is governed by the teachings of Islam, such as compassion, empathy, generosity and helping others in need.

This is implemented to emergency responses, eliminating poverty and its causes by developing innovative and sustainable projects in partnership with various reputable international relief agencies.

## VISION

Our vision is the alleviation of poverty, the enabling of education, and the provision of basic amenities for all.

# CARE FOR ORPHANS

An orphan in Islam is defined as a child who has lost his father or both of his parents. In Arabic, an orphan is called a yateem. The number of young children being orphaned is increasing. It is very difficult for orphans to survive on their own if they are not equipped with the right knowledge and life skills that are essential as they mature further into their lives.

Alhamdulillah, Global Ehsan Relief together with its international partners supports hundreds of orphans by providing them with food, clothing, shelter, as well as education. We believe every individual should not be denied the opportunity of a bright future.

## Umrah for Orphans

In January 2019, Global Ehsan Relief brought 12 Palestinian and 38 Syrian orphans, who are also refugees, on a trip to Mecca and Madinah. This educational trip provided them a whole new experience as this might be the only opportunity they have to travel and perform Umrah.

## Orphans Sponsorship

Currently there are a total of 307 orphans sponsored, consisting of 185 Hifz orphans and 122 Non-Hifz orphans. These orphans are schooled in an Islamic based school.

Tahfiz is part of their curriculum other than learning the basic subjects such as English, Maths, and their native language.

Apart from education, your contributions have benefitted them through providing them food, clothing and shelter as well. Our target in 2020 is to reach 500 orphans.

## Food Aid Distribution

Food Aid Distribution project has benefited many needy, and under-privileged families in countries such as Cambodia, Indonesia, and Sri Lanka.

People living in developing countries, especially in rural parts are the most deserving of these food aid packs which consist of non-perishable food items that can help to sustain them for a certain period and also ease their financial burden.

Without the food aid packs, it is difficult for these families to get by each day as they live in poverty and struggle with hunger.

Our projects in Singapore, such as "JomFeedBack", also encourages volunteers to come forward to assist in the contribution and distribution of the food aid packs to the homes of our beneficiaries.

In 2019, Global Ehsan Relief has distributed 4,420 food aid packs to different villages and communities.



# CARE FOR EDUCATION

Today, education remains an inaccessible right of millions of children worldwide. Many children are not in schools as they must work to support their family. Education can be costly, because there are also costs for educational materials such as uniforms, books, stationery and others.

The expenses may be too much for some families to afford which can result in the children lacking motivation to go to school to learn. There are many other factors preventing them from going to school however, poverty is still one of the biggest obstacles to a child's education.



## School Supply

Global Ehsan Relief is committed to help millions of children and refugees through providing them with school materials and other resources.

With the funds collected from our generous donors, we managed to **distribute a total of 505 stationery kits and 150 school bags** in Cambodia, Singapore and Sri Lanka.

## Bicycles

We were made known children from Luye in Tanga, Tanzania had to walk 5km to school every day. Many did not even have proper footwear and others just walked barefooted as they were unable to afford shoes.

As such, GER distributed **50 bicycles** to the most needy students who lived farthest from school.

# CARE FOR REFUGEES

## Jordan

The GER team went to Jordan in April for the opening ceremony of the new school for Syrian Refugees located at Ad-Dafyanah Refugee Camp.

The school will benefit about 65 students, aged 6-12 years old, from over 70 families. The team also carried out Uniform Distribution (65 sets), Kindness Day (200 sweets), and Food Aid Distribution (100 sets).



## Bangladesh, Rohingya Refugees

In Bangladesh, there are a staggering 1.1 million Rohingya people seeking refuge from brutal conditions in their home country. Most of them are in refugee camps which are fast becoming overcrowded and under-supplied, facing a severe lack of necessities like food, clean water and shelter.

In 2019, we managed to distribute a total of 300 food aid sets, 10 000 cooked meals, and 300 Kindness Day items to the Rohingya people there. We also provided them with 6 water trucks, each with a month's supply of clean water.

There are more than 6000 blind muslims in Indonesia alone. Most of them are living in poverty.

In 2019, we distributed 500 Braille Quran, 449 Quran, to our beneficiaries.



# GLOBAL WAKAF PROJECTS



## Water Well & Ablution Place

One of the biggest challenges faced by developing countries that suffer from poverty, famine or drought is the lack of access to clean water for drinking, sanitation purposes and ablution.

Water is essential to life yet millions of people, particularly those living in third world countries have little to no access to it. It is hard to find clean water in these countries where water is extremely contaminated.

In areas where land is arid and there is lack of water resources, Global Ehsan Relief provides communities with access to water by building wells and ablution places in Cambodia, Sri Lanka, Myanmar, Bangladesh and Pakistan.

## School Construction

In many rural Muslim communities, schools are underdeveloped and lack the adequate facilities. There is also a lack of Islamic curriculum, so the children are sadly unable to learn about the beauty of their religion. We rectify this by building new madrasahs in these communities, or refurbishing old ones and upgrading their conditions.

With our generous donors' support, we have built 2 new madrasahs in Cambodia this year, helping hundreds of young Muslims receive the education they deserve.



## Integrated Orphan Centre

Orphans are the most important part of the work we do. They are the most vulnerable demographic, with millions being forced into child labour or worse without a family to care for them.

In Aceh, thousands of orphaned children do not have the support they need to get a good education and live a fruitful life. Most orphanages are understaffed, and do not provide a well-rounded education that will adequately prepare the children for adult life.

With your help, we plan to build a sustainable long-term solution to this problem. Our Integrated Orphan Center will have all the facilities needed to provide orphans with a good home and a good education, including dormitories, classrooms, laboratories, a mosque, and so much more.

We aim to give these children a warm and caring home, as well as the tools they will need to flourish in their adulthoods. Your donations will contribute to their happiness and fulfilment, and ease the difficult path they have been placed on.

# MISSION TRIPS

## Community Involvement Programs (CIP)

### Aceh

Every year, we conduct volunteer trips to help needy communities in Aceh, Indonesia. It's a chance for people to experience humanitarian work, and see first-hand how difficult conditions are for others. The activities include packing and distribution 200 Food Aid Sets, Musolla refurbishment, organised picnic for 120 orphans, teach English to 120 students, distribute 400 free Ice Cream to public and distribute 70 cooked meals to the elderlies.

### Bangladesh

Bangladesh currently hosts more than 1 million Rohingya refugees. These refugees live in makeshift tents at camps in Bangladesh.

Winter season can be worrying as most of them don't have adequate clothing and shelter to protect themselves from the harsh cold. In November this year, Global Ehsan Relief has distributed 600 Food Aid Sets, 150 Winter Kits, 10,000 Cooked Meals, 150 Hygiene Kits, 10 Shelters, 150 School Bags, and 30,000 litres of clean water.

### Turkey

The number of Syrian refugees in Turkey is estimated at 3.7 million of which 44% of whom are children. Especially during winter, it can be extremely hard for them as they struggle to survive through the cold season.

In December, our team arrived in Sanliurfa to distribute 150 Winter Kits, 150 Hygiene Kits, 500 Food Aid Sets, 1,000 Baby Food, 2,000 Cooked Meals and refurbish a home.

## Mission Trips

### Tanzania, East Africa

Our Global Ehsan Relief team was in Tanzania, Africa in March 2019. Everyday, the villagers go out and search for food in the woods; mostly surviving on maize and cassava (tapioca). We managed to distribute 50 Food Aid Sets to needy families and children there, which comprise of rice, flour, maize, cooking oil, sugar, tea, macaroni were distributed in this remote village.

It provided food and nutrition to almost 300 women, children and the elderly. We also managed to construct a new mosque for the community there, named Al-Abideen mosque.

## Mission Of Hope (GERSG)

### Batam, Indonesia

This program is an initiative whereby participants can experience light humanitarian work providing aid relief for orphanages all around Batam Riau, Indonesia.

Activities conducted include improving the living conditions of the orphans, conducting short lessons, and distributing food packs to the poor villagers nearby.

# OTHER PROJECTS

## Kindness Day

We celebrate kindness by opening up an opportunity for people to give back to the community. With the public's kind donations, we are able to provide simple treats and gifts to the community and those in need.

## Care For Homeless

This project aims to reach out to destitutes in Singapore. At least 60 volunteers, both with vehicles and without, joined us as we walked the streets of Singapore on a quest to lend a helping hand to the homeless.

100 homeless people benefitted from this project as they received welfare kits for their daily use, it includes a bag, cooked food, a bottled water, a hygiene kit and more.

## Home Aid

As some families do not have the financial means to live in a well-furnished home, GER Singapore works together with volunteers to fundraise a certain amount to purchase. They are from a low-income family living in a rental home.

The refurbishment of the house included paint works, cleaning, removal of damaged items and furniture, and replacement and arrangement of new ones. Other contributions included a month's supply of diapers and milk powder, a refrigerator, and a washing machine.

## Charity Recycle Drive

This initiative was introduced to collect preloved or new clothes and soft toys, which will benefit the poor locally and overseas. We have collected 31,990 kg of recycled items and \$10,000 worth of clothes were distributed to most needy countries such as Syrian Refugees.
