



TOTAL DISBURSED

Global Ehsan Relief executed COVID-19 Emergency Relief, several Wakaf Projects and 5 Ramadan programmes aimed to help the orphans, refugees and the needy whose livelihoods' were affected by the pandemic.

The COVID-19 pandemic is not just a worldwide health crisis but also an economic one. To contain the virus and save lives, they must restrict movements and economic activity. Global Ehsan Relief aims to reach out to the vulnerable, especially the widows, orphans, elderly and refugees.

This year Ramadan is different, yet Muslims around the world welcome and observe the fasting month amidst the social isolation. We are overwhelmed at the generosity of our donors, and how they have supported our programmes that helped us deliver aid to 48,791 individuals in 16 countries.

Global Ehsan Relief executed several wakaf projects during Ramadhan 2020 in 6 different countries which has benefitted 4,575 beneficiaries. With a focus on poor and needy countries, these wakaf projects aim to benefit impoverished communities that lack the facilities and amenities to practise their religious responsibilities.

INDONESIA

MINI FOOD AID DISTRIBUTION

This project has enabled 60 honorary teachers and 33 small traders to feed their family. The package includes 5kg of rice, 1kg of sugar, 1kg of cooking oil, 1can of milk, 1 can of biscuit and 1 pack of rice noodle would be enough to cover the need of a family of 4 for at least 2 weeks.

HOT MEALS DISTRIBUTION

Free lunch were distributed to small traders, grab drivers, rickshaw driver and others. The distribution of these hot meals was carried out mainly outside GERID's office to ensure the implementation of all safety measures imposed by the government. A total of 1000 hot meals were distributed.

KIDS' MEALS DISTRIBUTION

Global Ehsan Relief Indonesia distributed a total 110 Kids meal pack each includes Cereal, Milk, Milky Biscuit and calcium biscuit, has been distributed for the orphans and dhuafa children.

60 Kid Meals packages were distributed to students at Dayah Mini and 50 more Kids Meals packages were distributed at Cahaya Aceh Foundation.

YEMEN

HYGIENE KITS DISTRIBUTION

Covid-19 has worsened the lives of the people of Yemen. In Ramadan 2020, 200 IDP families in Aden were selected and provided with hygiene kits to allow protective measures against COVID-19.

Each kit consists of antiseptic soap, soap package, detergent, washing powder, wet wipes, and towel. In total, 1,000 Yemenis benefitted from these hygiene kits distribution.







There are more than 70.8 million forcibly displaced people worldwide. Due to the lack of education and medical resources in various refugee camps and IDPs, without any proactive measures to educate and provide medical assistance/kits, the virus will spread very quickly and will result to more deaths.

HYGIENE KITS DISTRIBUTION

With the outbreak now reaching even in the refugee camps, Global Ehsan Relief, with the help of our partners, distributed 100 Hygiene Kit sets to 100 families. These essential kits were distributed at the IDP camps in Idlib north of Syria near to the Turkish border.

Each of these boxes contain soap, detergents, sanitizers, masks, gloves, personal cleaning kits, baby diapers, shower gels which are crucial in our fight to contain the COVID-19 pandemic from spreading.











HOT MEALS DISTRIBUTION

For these people who have lost everything - food, water and shelter are the basic necessities which they need at the moment. We distributed 500 hot meals were given out to the Syrian refugees at the Azaz and Babus Salem camps, close to the turkish border.

BREAD DISTRIBUTION

Bread is a staple food for the Syrians. During this very tiring and traumatic time, access to bread helps provide many Syrian families with a sense of normalcy and stability. Alhamdulillah in Azaz, Syria, with the assistance of our international NGO partners, 10,000 bread were given out to the Syrian refugees, each family receiving 10 bread.

ROHINGYA REFUGEE CAMP





Rohingya Refugees are facing multiple challenges - stuck in refugee camps far

from home, plus lockdown measures during this pandemic. Very little aid is coming in and they are struggling to survive. In response to the Covid-19 Emergency Appeal, 2,000 meals were prepared and served daily to the Rohingya refugees in Balukali refugee camps in Bangladesh for five days straight, amounting to a total of 10,000 meals.



Global Ehsan Relief Malaysia launched it's emergency aid campaign during this pandemic.

FACE MASKS & SHIELD DISTRIBUTION

We have frontliners taking care of those who are infected but they are fast running out of supplies. Global Ehsan Relief Malaysia stepped in to provide 500 face masks and shields to the frontliners at HSA Johor Bahru, in hopes that this humble contribution will help alleviate the hospital's shortage of surgical face masks.

FOOD AID & CASH HAND-OUT

In collaboration with Islamic Help, Global Ehsan Relief Malaysia managed to distribute 120 food aid packs to needy families in Johor Bahru and Perak. There are a total of 13 items in one pack which includes rice, cooking oil, flour, sugar, biscuit, maggi, noodles, condensed milk, tea, soy sauce, chilli sauce, cordial, and milo. The beneficiaries who are affected by loss of wages due to the lockdown were also given RM50 each.

SINGAPORE

The pandemic has resulted in some unprecedented outcomes such as closure of businesses, children missing school, and workers losing jobs.

For such reasons, Global Ehsan Relief Singapore has reached out to 20 families comprising of widows, single parents, the disabled, and those who were rendered unemployed from this pandemic. Through this project, these families received \$200 cash with a \$50 grocery voucher to tide them over and ease their grocery shop-













HYGIENE KITS

While COVID 19 is a threat to us all, its impact on Gaza could be catastrophic. Global Ehsan Relief distributed 100 sets of hygiene kits to families across Gaza, providing basic essentials, such as masks, soap, wet tissue paper, cleaning towels, nail

cutters, gloves and hand sanitisers.

As part of Global Ehsan Relief's COVID-19 Emergency Response together with our overseas partners, we ensured that the people of Gaza were cared for despite the unsettling situation. Thanks to GER donors worldwide, we also distributed 100 hot meals, 100 blankets and 100 mattresses to these families.

GAZA

SRI LANKA

The pandemic has raised fear among the Sri Lankan community as the virus continue to spread rapidly. They are suffering with no jobs and income, especially the women who are breadwinners are facing hardships without an alternative source income.

Global Ehsan Relief Sri Lanka provided support to families who lost their income by providing them with 400 family food aid packs that can help them survive during these tough times.







CAMBODIA







Masks are one of the most popular items being snagged as a precautionary

measure against COVID-19. While the country has officially only registered 122 coronavirus cases, it is still important to keep oneself protected. In these trying times, any form of help will assist these individuals and their families.

NaSa Cosmetic Company reached out to Global Ehsan Relief Cambodia and donated 50 hand sanitizers and 50 face masks. Our team distributed the items to the locals and also showed them how to use the mask and clean their hands with the hand sanitizer properly.

Distributed to 14 countries namely: Senegal, Indonesia, Gaza, Syria, Singapore, Cambodia, Malaysia, Yemen, Tanzania, Sri Lanka, Afghanistan, Al-Aqsa, Sudan and also the Rohingya Refugee Camp


Our beneficiaries in Singapore have benefited the most during this month where 7350 meals were distributed. A new initiative programme called "Ehsan Migrant Workers" was accomplished to support the migrant workers in Singapore who are mostly affected by the Covid-19. They received 350 sahur and 350 iftar meals.


The most needy families living at rental estates have also received 2400 meals along with 3000 packets of porridge. At the same time, the public received 1150 packets of porridge along with 500 roti jala.

Subsequently, our beneficiaries in Sri Lanka have received 3600 meals and 2000 meals were given in one of the top hosting refugee countries, in Syria.









Global Ehsan Relief, with the help of our partners, also managed to distribute 100 iftar meals to Tahfiz students at Dakar, Senegal for 2 consecutive days.

In the capital of Sudan, Khartoum, 500 iftar meals also were distributed in the district of Al-mujahideen.



Further up in Asia, in Cox Bazaar, Bangladesh, the Rohingya Refugees received 500 iftar meals. 1550 meals were distributed in Indonesia, 1045 meals in Malaysia, and 1591 meals in Cambodia.

During the last 10 days of Ramadhan, a total of 200 iftar meals were distributed to the beneficiaries in Faryap district, north of Afghanistan.

In Yemen, 500 meals were given out to the starved IDPs where over 3 million are internally displaced. The displaced Syrians near the town of Azaz, Syria also received 500 iftar meals. Due to the Covid-19 lockdown measures in Gaza, iftar meals were delivered house to house with a total of 514 meals.

The most needy families are battling poverty and only during such occasional seasons can they enjoy a meal like this. Each family gets to bond over a huge portion of delicious rice and grilled chicken.



FOOD AID SETS DISTRIBUTION

Over 5512 food aid sets have benefitted 27,560 orphans, widows and refugees across the world in 17 countries. The food aid came at the right time for some whose livelihood are affected by the COVID-19 lockdown and it could sustain livelihoods for at least 1 month for each family.

The low-wage workers in Indonesia have benefited most from the programme where 974 food aid sets were distributed.

The most affected during this time of upheaval are the refugees and IDPs where their livelihoods are affected. They have no income and are dependent on already strained aid efforts.

Refugees in Gaza received a total of 514 sets, those in Syria received 300 sets and Syrian refugees in Jordan received 100 sets. Our Rohingyans brothers and sisters living in Cox Bazaar received 200 food aid sets. Not forgetting those in Yemen, they have benefitted a total of 500 food aid sets.

We have distributed the most number of food aid sets in countries across Southeast Asia. In addition to Sri Lanka and Indonesia, Malaysia received 397 sets and Cambodia received 380 sets. Singapore received 182 sets, Afghanistan received 100 sets.


In Northeast Africa where poverty has further plunged due to the lockdown measures, the most needy receive little support for their basic needs. In the capital of Somalia, 100 food aid packs were distributed to the internally displaced families at Mogadishu IDP camps in hopes to alleviate their suffering.

In Tanzania, 100 food aid parcels were distributed to the most needy villagers in Tanga just a day before Ramadhan. 35 sets of food parcels each weighing 40 kilograms were distributed to the widows. Items include basic food like rice, beans, dates and other essentials. This will get them through until after Eid, for about a month, depending on the number of children in their household.

Together with our international partners, 100 food aid sets were distributed to Tahfiz student from Darussalam Quran Madrasah in Dakar, Senegal and another 100 food aid sets distributed in the district of Hartum, Sudan.

130 food aid sets were distributed in Mali. Such efforts are aimed to reduce poverty and hunger for million in Africa. In the Middle East, 514 food aid sets were distributed to the poor, needy, elderly and vulnerable groups in Gaza City. 300 food aid sets were distributed in Syria, 200 food aid sets in Yemen, 100 food aid sets in Mafraq, Jordan and 100 sets in Jerusalem Al-Aqsa.





BABY CARE PACKAGE



In times of hardship, some mothers in low-income families are struggling with the basic needs of their child, especially single mothers who might feel helpless on their own without the support of family members or other organizations.

Global Ehsan Relief Singapore embarked on a new project during Ramadhan - "Ehsan Baby Care Package" to give support to individuals, especially single mothers in low-income families who are struggling to provide basic essential needs for their child, such as milk and diapers. We distributed a total of 19 sets of Milk powder and Diapers to 19 babies.







EID GIFTS DISTRIBUTION



PRAYER TOOLS DISTRIBUTION

During this blessed month, we managed to raise funds and distributed prayer tools for both men and women to our Global Ehsan partners. In Cambodia, families have received 100 sets whereas in Indonesia 150 sets were given to the orphans.





On the eve of Eid, our Gaza team spent the day bringing out 100 orphans out shopping to bring some festive cheer to these beautiful children, showering them with Eid Gifts - new clothes, toys, sweets and chocolates.

125 orphans in Indonesia have also benefited from the fundraising of Eid Gifts, and 100 sets distributed to Sri Lanka.

Keeping our orphan children happy is our top priority hence we hope these eid gifts will cheer them up considering some may be dispirited due to strict measures imposed during Covid-19 lockdown.

ZAKAT DISTRIBUTION

Giving charity and zakat, which is one of the five pillars of Islam, is encouraged during Ramadan.

Zakat is one of the five pillars of Islam. Muslims whose savings meet or exceed certain values are obliged to give 2.5% of their annual savings to the poor and needy and for the welfare of the Muslim community.

Global Ehsan Relief has successfully raised for 120 zakat beneficiaries in Aceh and 100 families in Gaza to

The construction of a brand new masjid was completed in Ramadhan in Cambodia. Yusof Abu Bakar Mosque was built in Kampong Thom - a province of Cambodia. This masjid could serve a jemaah of 250. Prior to the construction to this masjid, the community did not have a masjid for congregational prayers and communal activities.








COMMUNITY WATER WELL

Global Ehsan Relief has built its first ever wakaf community water well in Cambodia in the month of Ramadhan. It serves a community of 50 people who would otherwise walk miles to the river bank to attain clean water.



The construction of this water well allowed the community to perform their Ibadah and prepare food for iftar and sahur in Ramadhan with ease and without the risk of illness. On top of that, it will be safe for watering crops, and feeding livestock which could protect the villagers' livelihoods.

WATER WELLS

As a solution to the lack of clean water in rural villages, Global Ehsan Relief builds water pumps which are ideal for households. Suction hand pumps, which are made of cast iron, are cheap, easy to install, and maintain.


Maintenance is done at the village level without the need for specialist parts. 32 wakaf water wells were built in Cambodia, and 118 were built in Sri Lanka thanks to the wakaf donations of Global Ehsan Relief supporters.

One water well is built for one household of 5 people in mind, bringing a total of 750 beneficiaries that can utilise them.

ABLUTION PLACE

An ablution place provides users with water for years and years. In rural areas, they are a lifeline for the inhabitants as they may be the only source of potable water. With this ablution place, people living in remote areas will be able to take their ablution before praying and other daily purposes such as drinking, cleaning, and washing.









25 ablution places were built in Cambodia during Ramadhan. One ablution place is built for a community of 35 people, bringing a total of 875 beneficiaries that can utilise them.

QURAN DISTRIBUTION




Global Ehsan Relief distributed wakaf Quran to recipients in four countries during the month of Ramadhan. This allows them the opportunity to read, recite, and learn about the Quran. When you wakaf a Quran, you will continuously reap the rewards of the person utilising it for as long as they do so.

650 were distributed in Aceh, Indonesia. During one of the distributions, our Global Ehsan Relief team in Indonesia was faced with an obstacle of flooding in North Aceh. Despite that, the beneficiaries still came out to receive their very own Mushaf as it was something they were heavily anticipating.

1,000 Mushaf were distributed to Rohingya refugees in Myanmar. As displaced people in their home country, they receive little to no opportunity to learn about or practise their religion. Receiving a wakaf Quran is a form of refuge for them to seek solace from Allah's words amidst a long-term crisis.

500 Mushaf were distributed in Uganda as well as Kenya. 14% of Uganda's and 11% of Kenya's population are made up of Muslims. In these countries, more than 30% of its population live below the poverty line. As minority groups that live in poverty-stricken communities, they may not even have access to the Quran. Receiving a Mushaf is a privilege afforded to them by your wakaf.


